Frequency; 146.520 MHz Simplex
Our Node Number: 1188

To connect:

To connect to a node or reflector simply key up your radio, identify yourself and the node you're calling the dial the 4 digit number for that node/reflector.

To disconnect: Key your mic, dial 73

Important Notes:

- PAUSE - PAUSE - PAUSE! - Wait after keying your mic to allow the IRLP system to key up all the nodes and get everything going. If you start talking too fast you will get cut off.

- Remember to disconnect!
- The node is currently on simplex but the plan is to link it in to our repeaters. I will send out an email as this develops.
- The node is primarily for club members. Although there is currently no restriction to who can use the node, if others want to use it please encourage them to pay their \$10 and help the club out.
- I am the node maintainer. If you are having problems with the node, or it is causing problems please send me an email @ james@va6fm.net and I will look at it asap. If the node is misbehaving badly (ie: causing piles of noise, or keyed up permanently) you can call me at 403-952-7550.
